

NORM VIII ORAL AND POSTER PRESENTATIONS

ORAL PRESENTATIONS

When preparing your presentation slides, keep the time limit for your presentation in mind. The presentations should be concise as time is very tight. Because of that, the session chairs are instructed to adhere to the timetable **strictly**.

- Contributed oral presentations are **15-minute long**. Questions will be addressed in the discussion session, after all presentations.
- The paper must be presented by the author or one of the co-authors.
- The presentation file should be uploaded directly at the session room before the session starts.

Poster and Poster Short Oral Presentation

- The poster should be displayed at the Poster Room in the morning of the scheduled day of presentation.
- The size of the printed poster is 94 cm wide x 120 cm high.
- The author should be available for explanations on his/her poster during the Coffee Break.

Poster Short Oral Presentation

- A poster short oral presentation **IS REQUIRED** from all poster presenters. The time slot is 2 min for the oral presentation (see program) at the main room. Except by the posters of Natural Radioactivity Session-4, which short presentations will be at the poster room.
- The poster presentation file should be submitted directly at the session room in the morning of the day scheduled for the presentation.
- Only digital files of the poster presentation in PDF format with 3 slides can be accepted for the poster short presentation.
- Contents of the poster short presentation slides should cover: slide 1) Title, Presenter Name and Organization/Institution; slide 2) Objectives and Methodology and slide 3) Summary of Results.

Certificates will be available online after the event. Access will be provided through the registration login and password of each participant, on the Congress website. Certificates will be awarded for participation in the Congress, courses, lectures and abstract presentations.
